



Work Health and Safety Policy Statement

National Facades Australia is firmly committed to providing and maintaining a safe and healthy working environment for employees, clients, subcontractors, visitors and members of the public. We recognise and accept our collective responsibilities under the relevant National and State Work Health & Safety Acts and Regulations, and these obligations have been articulated in the NFA Policy document – NFA OPS 2-2 Safety Management System.

National Facades Australia has assigned and committed the resources to ensure this policy is enabled to deliver a safe workplace. Responsibilities under our Safety Management System include:

Management Responsibility	Worker Responsibility
Provide a safe working environment	Comply with safe work practices, with the intent of avoiding injury to themselves and others and damage to plant and equipment
Ensure safe systems of work	Take reasonable care of the health and safety of themselves and others
Ensure plant and substances are in a safe working condition	Wear personal protective equipment and clothing where necessary
Provide facilities for the welfare of workers	Comply with any direction given by management for health and safety
Provide information, instruction, training and supervision that is reasonably necessary to ensure that each worker is safe from injury and risks to health	Do not misuse or interfere with anything provided for health and safety
Commit to consult and co-operate with workers in all matters relating to health and safety in the workplace	Report all accidents and incidents on the job immediately, no matter how trivial
Commit to continually improve our performance through effective safety management.	Report all known or observed hazards to their supervisor or manager.

In doing this, I expect all NFA employees and subcontractors to be responsible for their own safety as much as they are for others in our workplace – look after your mates.

Our goal is to create a zero incident workplace (factory and site) for 2016 - we all share the responsibility to make sure this is achieved.
